S.1	In order to replace a pipe under an existing length of guiderall, the contractor needed to remove and reset a length of beam guiderall located at approximetly 32+25L.
S2	Due to a conflict with existing guiderail at 32+25R, the contractor reconstructed an existing B inlet instead of upgrading to a double B inlet per the plan.
\$3	The existing curb in front of the guiderail at approximetly Station 32+25L had a reveal of 6", greater than the 2" reveal allowed in front of tangent terminal guiderail. The contractor was instructed to sawcut the guiderail in order to achieve compliance.
\$4	During the installation of the wiring for the new pedestrian push buttons at the intersection with Coles Road/Hider Lane, it was discovered that the existing conduit did not have room for new wiring. As a result, a secondary conduit was installed to complete the wiring.
